SPECIFICATION FOR BLACK & WHITE TACK

Description

A high performance strip sealant which is ideal for use where extra strength and adhesive characteristics are required, for example when joining plastic membranes. Approved for use with portable water.

Standard colours - black and white.

Uses

Roofing and Cladding:

For high performance side and end lap joint sealing.

For sealing metal gutter joints.

For sealing around eaves and ridge fillers.

For joining vapour barrier membranes.
