## LINSEED OILS

### Boiled Linseed Oil

Made from pressed ripe flax seeds. Boiled linseed is generally superior to raw linseed for most uses and it dries much more quickly.

### Raw Linseed Oil

The cricketer's choice Raw Linseed Oil is slow-drying but slightly more durable than the Boiled version under extreme conditions when used in industrial paints.

## TEREBINE DRIERS

### Terebine Driers

A special blend of chemicals to speed the drying of oil- and alkyd-based paints and varnishes. Particularly recommended for adding to old paint and varnish that has been kept for a long time and has become slow-drying or when working in sub-optimal conditions. Add a small capful to 0.5 L of paint. Over very long periods Terebine Driers can make the paint go slightly brittle so use sparingly. To retard drying times see Owatrol [page 14]. UN 1263

## THINNERS & STRIPPERS

### White Spirit

Used to clean brushes and rollers and to thin conventional oil-based paints. See also Genuine Turpentine . UN 1300

### Clean Spirit

Water based, low odour alternative to White Spirit for cleaning up brushes and rollers but do not use for thinning paint - it will ruin it.

### Methylated Spirit

Used to dilute shellac-based products and clean up brushes. Also widely used to remove grease from steel prior to painting. UN 1170.

### Isopropyl Alcohol [IPA]

Ideal for wiping down prior to painting or varnishing. White spirit is slow to evaporate whereas Isopropyl evaporates quickly reducing the chances of solvent entrapment. Isopropyl is a useful azeotrope forcing moisture out of substrates. UN 1219 Aerosol: UN 1950

### Cellulose Thinners

For use with cellulose-based paint systems. UN 1263

### Acetone

A volatile thinner often used for aggressive cleaning. Useful to remove oily residues from teak etc. prior to varnishing. Highly inflammable. UN 1090.

### Xylene

Sometimes used to draw blooming patches from glazed floors. Before embarking on this method try a gentle fan heater blowing warmed air over the patch. Highly inflammable. UN 1263

### Genuine Turpentine

Made from the distillation of sap from pine trees. The volatile distillate is known as "spirits of turpentine" and the resin is known as "Rosin" [page 71]. Its rate of evaporation is ideal for most oil-based paints and varnishes. UN 1263

### Polyvine Varnish & Paint Remover

Solvent free, water based varnish and paint remover from Polyvine. Removes multiple layers of paint in one go. Apply liberally on to the surface with a brush (you might want to give the bottle a shake to help it flow better!), leave on, and simply scrape away the paint/varnish.

As a rough guide, leave the remover on the surface for...

- 15 - 30 mins for thin layers of varnishes/shellac
- 30 - 45 mins for acrylic paint
- 1 hour +/overnight for multiple layers (best covered with cling film if left overnight to prevent the remover from drying out)

Suitable for all surfaces but always worth applying on a small test area before starting in earnest.
